> Details about the program

- Practice with be held twice per week (TBD on practice times and days)
- Organization guarantees approx. 7-10 tournament games per season
- Tournaments starts mid-March and run through July
- 2 3 tournaments will require out of state travel (more details as season commences)
- Tournaments are normally held Friday, Saturday and Sunday. If traveling out of state – Sat/Sun only
- Parent must register their player online at <u>www.lightoutballers.com</u>
- All players must provide a copy of Birth Certificate and most recent report/progress report. Please import a copy of via LOB website. If returning player, you do not need to resend birth certificate

> Dues for the 2020 LOB Association total for \$500 each player

- \$50.00 deposit due within 3 days of roster being displayed this confirms your spot
- Payment arrangements are welcome; however, fees must be paid by 1st day of practice (TBD)
- Returning player's fee \$400 (if no uniform is needed)
- Payment methods: Log onto LOB website to pay AAU and deposit via

- To opt out of the fundraiser participation a fee of \$150 will be required for each player.

Included in these fees are the following:

- Gym practice fees
- Gym floor maintenance
- Coaches gear, membership fees to the AAU Association
- Insurance and other organizational fees

- 1. Q. How do I find more information about the Lights Out Ballers Association?

 - A. Tournament plays start mid-March
- 7. Q. Does this organization include out of town tournaments?
 - A. We would like to participate in at least 2-3 out of town tournaments, but the association does not fund these programs, therefore the funding will be solely dependent on donations and additional fundraising events.
